ENROLMENT POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- Enrolment is for the entire year - with fees paid by the term
- All term fee invoices will be issued prior to the end of term (with the exception of Term 1 where you will receive an invoice prior to the beginning of the term)
- All accounts must be settled by the dates specified.
- A \$25 administration fee will apply to every late notice/invoice sent out.
- All outstanding accounts must be settled 1 month prior to the end of year concert.
- After the commencement of classes no refunds will be given to students.
- No refunds or credits are available for missing a class due to sickness or injury.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If a student intends to discontinue classes during the year they must notify Crazy Feet **in writing via email** 2 weeks prior to the end of that term. If you receive an invoice via email and cancel after the invoice has been issued you will be subject to paying a cancellation fee of \$50.

NEWSLETTERS & NOTICE BOARD POLICIES

Crazy Feet will provide an e- newsletter each term. Please ensure you read all of these as they include important dates and information for parents. Also keep an eye on our website crazyfeetdance.com.au & our instagram page for exciting updates and events.

CONCERT POLICIES

- Our annual performance is held at the Besen Centre in November. It is not compulsory for students to take part in the performance; however, it is assumed that all students will take part. The concert is a lot of fun and is the highlight of our year. If your child will not be appearing in the concert you must inform the office before Monday the 15th of July otherwise costume hire fee is still payable.
- All concert dances are learnt in class. There is a compulsory studio rehearsal and theatre rehearsal as well as the performance.

COSTUME POLICY

Costumes are provided by the school and are hired out to the students for a fee. Parents are not required to do any sewing or handling of costumes. Invoices for costume hire are sent out in Term 3. You must notify us if you are not doing the concert before Monday 15th of July, otherwise costume hire is still payable.

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

- Appropriate emergency procedures exist and staff understand the procedures relevant to their location.
- It is the responsibility of the student or parent/guardian to inform us of any prior or current illnesses or injuries prior to enrolment or prior to class.
- It is our policy that students do not attend classes if suffering from a contagious illness to protect other studio attendees. Students can attend make up classes where possible upon recovery.
- In the event of an injury, we will administer First Aid treatment by a qualified first aider. If medical services are necessary and an ambulance required, the student/parent will incur the costs.
- Parents/Guardians must be responsible for minors before and after class times.
- No student (under 18 years) is to wait outside or leave the premises unaccompanied by a parent or guardian.
- We must be notified of any allergies that a student may have.
- Students must not bring any food containing nuts into the studio or at concert rehearsals/performances.
- Any student who has been diagnosed by a Medical Practitioner as being at risk of anaphylaxis should bring an epipen to class and leave it at reception, labeled with their name. This epipen will be administered by a first aider if required.
- Emergency evacuation maps are located around the premise. Fire extinguishers, fire hose reels and fire blankets are located within the premises.
- All government COVID-19 policies & vaccinations policies apply
- We have a child safety policy which can be found on our website

POLICIES & CONDITIONS

WATCHING CLASS POLICIES & OPEN DAYS

It is the policy of Crazy Feet that parents do not stay and watch classes in the studio. There will be open days in Term 1 & 2 for parents and friends to watch and view the student's progress. Term 3 & 4 do not have open days due to concert preparation. Dates for open days are announced in the newsletters.

INJURY POLICIES

It is the responsibility of the student or parent to inform the teacher before class of any injuries, including those injuries that are being treated or may be of concern during class. A first aid box is available at the studio. Due to government legislation we are unable to provide any children with Panadol or equivalent medication.

ASTHMA AND ANAPHYLAXIS POLICY

We must be notified of ALL allergies a student may have. Please complete details on enrolment form and ask for an action plan form at reception. Please return the completed action plan before attending classes.

LOST PROPERTY

All items left at Crazy Feet will be placed in lost property. They will NOT be kept separately at reception for people to collect. Please do not call and ask for this to be done. Lost property will be emptied at the end of each term and given to charity.

CLASSICAL BALLET REQUIREMENTS

Ballet develops a child's posture, musicality, discipline and movement skills, while providing a strong technical foundation. Crazy Feet teaches the internationally recognised Cecchetti Syllabus and students take part in exams and assessments. Please note that ballet grades are not the same as their grade at school. New students are assessed and placed in the appropriate classes for their levels. For ballet students wishing to take part in examinations, you must meet the requirements for the particular level. Please read below for the requirements.

- **Pre-Primary** - Prep at school - 1 class of ballet a week
- **Primary** - Grade 1 at school - 1 class of ballet a week
- **Grade 1 Ballet** - Grade 2-3 at school - 1-2 classes of ballet a week
 - *Grade 1 Ballet (grade 2 at school) students take one class per week for the Term 1 and progress to two classes in Term 2 to prepare for the exam. Grade 1 ballet students who wish to excel may take 2 classes a week from the start of the year.*
- **Grade 2 Ballet** - Grade 3 at school & above - 2 ballet classes a week
- **Grade 3 Ballet** - Grade 4 at school & above - 2 ballet classes a week
- **Grade 4 Ballet** - Grade 5 at school & above - 2 ballet classes a week
- **Grade 5 Ballet** - Grade 6 at school & above - 2 ballet classes a week
- **Grade 6 Ballet** - Year 7 at school & above - 2-3 ballet classes a week
- **Intermediate Ballet** - Year 8 at school & above - 2-3 ballet classes a week
- **Advanced Ballet 1**- Year 9 at school & above, 4-5 hours a week
- **Advanced Ballet 2**- Year 12 and above, 4-5 hours a week

Examinations are held annually. The final decisions on who partakes in examinations will be made by the teachers. Students move up to the next level after successfully completing the exam.
